



## EXCURSIONS FROM LISBON



### HALF DAY LISBOA

A tour to discover the city, promenading in one of the typical old quarters of **Lisbon, Alfama**, walking through its narrow streets with arab influences. Then, visit of the **Royal Coach Museum** where one can find the world's largest collection of Royal Coaches), the **Jerónimos Monastery** and the **Belém Tower**, both good examples of the 16th century's Manueline style (gothic) and finally the **Monument to the Discoveries**.

#### LISBON TOUR

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### Half day « OCEANÁRIO »

Departure to the new part of Lisbon, Nations Park, former site of Expo 98 to visit the Oceanarium, the pavilion houses the largest Oceanarium in Europe, recreating the ecosystems of the North Atlantic, Pacific, the Indian Ocean, and Antarctica, around a huge central basin. 25,000 fish, birds and mammals await visitors in the most ambitious attempt to date business to illustrate the most diverse oceanic regions of the planet.

Free time to enjoy the beautiful gardens, enjoy a coffee in the many cafes or shopping plazas or in the new Vasco da Gama Shopping Centre.





### DINNER WITH FADO SHOW

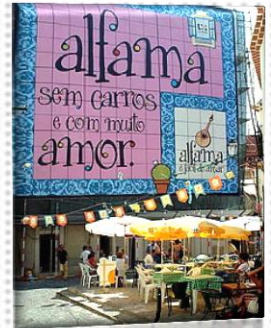
- Transportation to/from a typical restaurant in one of Lisbon's most picturesque quarters - assistance to "Fado" and Folklore shows.

### Half day ESTORIL – SINTRA – CASCAIS

- Visit of the medieval village of **Sintra**, former Royal summer residence and chosen to inspire writers and poets, such as Lord Byron who named it "The Garden of Eden". Visit of the **National Palace "da Villa"**, that houses a beautiful collection of glazed tiles, proceeding to **Cape "da Roca"** - the westernmost point in continental Europe, the beaches of **Guincho**, **Cascais** and **Estoril** - renamed seaside resorts, returning to Lisbon along the coast.
- **ARRÁBIDA**
- Departure towards the south, cross of the imponent bridge over the river "Tejo", to visit the old castle of **Palmela**. Then **Azeitão**, visit and wine tasting at a famous "**Moscatel**" **Wine Cellar**, **Sesimbra** - characteristic piscatoric village, returning to Lisbon across Arrábida's ridge of mountains and its beautiful natural park.

### Full day LISBON COAST –Queluz /Sintra / Estoril

- A Romantic excursion. Visit of Queluz Palace - Sumptuous 18th century rooms . Mafra, visit of the Basilica. Ericeira - charming seaside resort. Lunch. Visit of the medieval village of **Sintra**, former Royal summer residence and chosen to inspire writers and poets, such as Lord Byron who named it "The Garden of Eden". Visit of the **National Palace "da Villa"**, that houses a beautiful collection of glazed tiles, proceeding to the beaches of **Guincho**, **Cascais** and **Estoril** - renamed seaside resorts, returning to Lisbon along the coast.
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### EVORA – The Héritage of UNESCO

- A full day to discover **Évora**, named of “Museum-Town” and considered by UNESCO as worldwide patrimony - visit of the **Temple of Diana**, the **Cathedral** and **S. Francisco Church** with its macabre **Bones Chapel**. Lunch by a local restaurant. Arriving in Lisbon by evening.

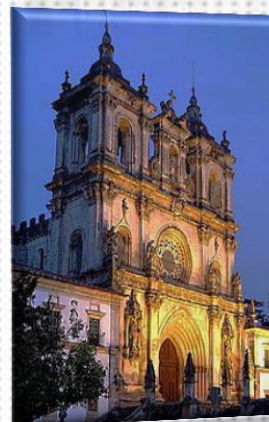
### FULL DAY Obidos / Alcobaça / Nazaré

- Early depart towards **Óbidos** - visit of this medieval village surrounded by the walls of its castle and typical for its white limed houses and wrought iron balconies, and on to **Nazaré** the most typical and colourful fishing village in Portugal, known for its tasty gastronomy with special reference to the fish menus. Lunch in typical restaurant. Continuation to **Batalha**, visit of the splendid **Stª Maria Victória Monastery** - masterpiece of the Portuguese gothic style with a fine lace work decoration and **Fátima** - centre of world pilgrimages.

### Full Day Alcobaça / Nazaré / Batalha / Fatima

Departure to Alcobaça to visit the church where the Cistercian Monastery resting Dom Pedro and Inês de Castro beautiful "queen dead." Continue to Nazare an old fishing town known for the costumes and traditions

Lunch at Nazaré . After lunch departure to visit the Batalha Monastery of Santa Maria Victoria, a masterpiece of Portuguese Gothic. Continue to Fatima for the discovery of this important sanctuary. Even if it is refractory to the cities of pilgrimage and their commercialism of sometimes questionable taste, a visit to Fatima is required .
